4. Video Content License

This license grants access to use the content as permitted by these Terms but does **not** transfer ownership of:

Users may not:

- Download videos unless specifically authorized in writing.
- Record or capture video content.
- Upload videos or portions of videos to social media platforms, YouTube, websites, or public forums.



- Reproduce, modify, edit, distribute, sell, sublicense, or publicly broadcast content.
- Share login credentials with unauthorized users.
- Use content for commercial purposes without written permission.

Unauthorized distribution or misuse of Worthy Talks Institute materials may result in

- Immediate termination of access.
- Loss of subscription privileges.
- Additional legal action to protect intellectual property rights.

5. Educational Display License

Worthy Talks Institute provides organizations with a limited educational display license allowing subscribed users to display videos in:
